these presents do or may come — —

I, The Much honoured and Right Rev'd James,
Baron of Buittle, Bishop of Whithorn, of the castle and
fortalice of Buittle in the County of Kirkcudbright, which Barony was cre-
ated by Charter under the Great Seal dated Twenty-fourth February, One
Thousand Three Hundred and Twenty Five by Robert, King of Scots, in
favour of our right worthy forebear Sir James Douglas, Lord of Douglas, and
which Barony was duly assigned to me, do hereby constitute and appoint —

Fellow of the Society of Antiquaries, Scotland, historian of Clan Donald in
the United States of America, **herald and Genealogist** in the Baron Court
of Buittle. I further decree, motu proprio, that this commission shall continue
at my pleasure, and until the same shall be recalled or revoked by me or my
successors. **IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF** I have caused these letters
patent to be made, at my Castle of Buittle, in the 69th year of the Reign of
Our Sovereign Lady Elizabeth the Second, MMXX AD.
